Commissioner Katie Anderson called the meeting to order at 9:40 a.m. The minutes of the December 8, 2010 meeting were approved on a motion by Commissioner Foster, and seconded by Commissioner Miller.

Updates: Darleen Okammor, Energy Assistance Program Manager, updated the Committee on the progress of the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP), Gulf Coast Energy Crisis Program and the Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP).

On Wednesday, January 12, 2011, the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services Secretary Kathleen Sebelius announced the availability of \$1.6 billion additional funds for the LIHEAP program, which will bring the funding total up to \$3.95 billion dollars.

This is the third release of funds under continuing resolutions for Fiscal year 2011 and Louisiana's total allocation is \$46,108,754.00, which is an additional \$14,090,565.00.

Last week, she learned that there are still families affected by the Gulf Coast oil spill who need energy assistance, in light of which, she advised that staff is working on conducting more outreach to inform the residents of how to apply for services. Currently, the Agency has a remaining balance of \$42,239.00 set-aside for the initiative, whereas these funds received from DNR will not expire.

On December 16, 2010, the Department of Energy (DOE) notified the Agency of the release of the remaining 50%, about \$25,328,739.00, of the ARRA-WAP Grant of \$50,657,478.00. The DOE's headquarters also expressed a desire to do a press release about this milestone where they would coordinate with LHFA's Public Information office.

This concluded Ms. Okammor's report.

Commissioner Foster requested with the approval of madam chair that the Agency disburse the funds immediately upon receipt.

LACAP Monthly Reports:

Jon Phelps, Energy Director, began with an update of the ARRA WAP Max Program, which was included in the Committees' binders. He advised as noted in the report notes the completion of the monthly desk reviews for all the agencies as of November 2010. The expectations are to notify any agency that failed to meet the production quota. There were three (3) agencies that failed to meet their expectations, which were Allen Action Agency, Avoyelles Progress Action Committee, Inc. (APAC), and Desoto Parish Police Jury. LACAP advised the agencies via correspondence of the severity of not meeting production. As of December they have met production.

Commissioner Anderson interjected to advise with a more in-depth explanation for those Commissioners most recently added to the Energy Assistance Committee.

He also advised of those with a two (2) month failure to produce category expectation number seven (7). There were two (2) agencies--St. John and Total Community Action Agency--who fell into that category. There were meetings held at LACAP with both agencies which produced results and he hopes it continues.

He informed the audience that there was no recent news on the regular program.

This concluded Mr. Phelps' report.

ARRA Reporting Updates: Regarding production, by the end of December they were forty-six (46) percent complete statewide and at the end of January they are expecting to be at fifty (50) percent complete statewide, which ties into the budget issues expressed earlier.

The January monthly metric report indicated there were 199 full-time equivalent jobs created as a result of the ARRA Weatherization in the State.

Rene Landry, Chief Fiscal Officer (CFO) injected to advise the audience and remind LACAP that the fiscal year end was October 31, 2010 and six months later April 30, 2011 is the due date.

Commissioner Anderson opened the floor to entertain questions and/or comments. There being no other business to discuss, Commissioner Anderson adjourned the meeting at 10:12 a.m.

The following resolution was offered by Commissioner _____ and seconded by Commissioner _____:

RESOLUTION

A resolution approving and authorizing the Agency to enter into a Professional Services Agreement for Davis Bacon Compliance Services for the ARRA Louisiana Weatherization Assistance Program (hereinafter referred to as “ARRA WAP”) or, in the alternative, to hire a temporary employee to provide such services; and providing for other matters in connection therewith.

WHEREAS, on February 17, 2009, the President of the United States signed into law bill H.R. 1 (commonly referred to as the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009) awarding an additional \$50,657,478.00 (fifty million, six hundred fifty-seven thousand, four hundred seventy-eight dollars) to the State of Louisiana in addition to the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency’s current Weatherization Assistance Program for training, technical assistance and for the weatherizing of qualified homes; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2009, the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency's (the “Agency”) Board of Commissioners (the “Board”) approved a resolution accepting and approving the Louisiana Weatherization Assistance Program (“WAP”), and authorized the execution of a contract with the Louisiana Association of Community Action Partnerships, Inc. (“LACAP”) for administration, monitoring, training and technical assistance through the end of the WAP; and

WHEREAS, as a result of an audit of the WAP conducted by the United States Department of Energy (“DOE”) made it necessary for the Agency to remove Davis Bacon compliance services from the responsibility of LACAP and instead contract with a third party to provide such services for the duration of the ARRA WAP or hire a temporary employee to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, the Agency released a Request for Proposals for Davis Bacon Compliance Services on January 5, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Agency’s staff has received and is reviewing the proposals submitted in response to the Request for Proposals for Davis Bacon Compliance Services, and may desire to enter into a contract for those services if after completing the review, staff concludes that there is a proposal that meets all of the qualifications necessary to provide said services; and

WHEREAS, in the alternative, Agency's staff may desire to hire a temporary employee to provide Davis Bacon Compliance Services, and will conduct a search for such a qualified

applicant in accordance with the rules and regulations governing the hiring of temporary employees.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Louisiana Housing Finance Agency, acting as the governing authority of said Agency, that:

SECTION 1. The Agency is hereby approved and authorized to enter into a Professional Service Agreement or to hire a temporary employee for Davis Bacon Compliance Services for the ARRA Louisiana Weatherization Program.

SECTION 2. The Agency's staff and counsel are authorized and directed to prepare such documents and agreements as may be necessary to either enter into a contractual relationship or to hire a temporary employee for the provision of Davis Bacon Compliance Services for the Louisiana Weatherization Program, as per the final decision of the President.

SECTION 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman, President, Vice President, and/or Secretary of the Agency are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute any forms and/or documents required to be executed on behalf of and in the name of the Agency, the terms of which are to be consistent with the provisions of this resolution.

Monthly Desk Reviews

Expectation Number 5: Contractor shall conduct monthly desk reviews of the Subgrantees using information in the HES database and reports, as requested by Contractor, of Subgrantees. Protocol for monitoring must be agreed upon by LHFA and Contractor. LACAP conducted a desk review for the month of December, 2010, for all Subgrantees.

One Month Failure to Produce

Expectation Number 6: For the month of December, 2010, there were three agencies that fell into this category; Caddo, SMILE and St. Tammany. A letter was sent to each agency by LACAP.

Two Month Failure to Produce

Expectation Number 7: For the month of December, 2010, one agency fell into this category, Allen. Allen is significantly ahead in its production. No counseling needed.

Four Month Failure to Produce

Expectation Number 8: For the month of December, 2010, no agencies fell into the four month category.
