

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Nearly 1,000 new applications started last week</li><li>4<sup>th</sup> consecutive week of over 400 submitted applications (100%) and ~400 landlords matches to tenants</li><li>\$1.6M awarded last week</li><li>Average award is \$6,331/tenant</li><li>Utility Assistance<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>3,014 Utility Requests Received</li><li>2,248 for Power</li><li>766 Water, Sewer, Trash, Gas</li></ul></li><li>\$727,516 = Total Estimated Utility Request Amount (not all Energy requests reported the amount due and therefore this value will be higher)</li></ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Hosted the 1<sup>st</sup> 4 of 10 in-person application assistance events last week in Tangipahoa, Bossier, Terrebonne, and St. Landry. 128 applicants assisted – combo of new applicants and current applicants<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>More than 1,000 have scheduled appointments across all events</li></ul></li><li>Streamlining review processes for submitted application by confirming data using 3<sup>rd</sup> party tax ID validation – will streamline case management and approval</li><li>Instituted regular budget meetings and are streamlining processes for efficiency and cost savings</li><li>Finalizing processes to pay tenants directly when landlords refuse to participate and begin paying directly</li><li>Met with Apartment Association and Realtor Association to get input and discuss program outreach with landlords.</li></ul>
