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Comments on the Draft QAP for 2013 Credits/HOME

1. The 24 Hour Security is completely unrealistic to include in the QAP as stated/defined. While security is important, it can be accomplished in a cost effective manner on the front end with the installation of cameras/monitioring system during construction. Although this is a points issue and not a requirement, we all understand that the entire program is points driven. No affordable housing property can operate with such an ongoing expense. For example; At a minimum of \$10/hour, 24 hours a day x 365 days = over \$87,000 to include in an operating budget.
2. With the QAP/plan still in Draft form and the public hearing not until April 13, then final approval; the timeline for a deadline of May 25th is seemingly not reasonable. Mid or late June seems a more reasonable time frame.
3. Scattered site should be pointed on an even basis with other types of development to allow multifamily apartment style units to compete with equal opportunity.
